



Aggie Grotto Cave Trip Packing List

Caving Gear Provided By Grotto:

- Frog Vertical System
 - Micro-rack
 - Cows Tails
 - Hand Ascender with foot loops
 - Chest Ascender
- Helmet

Caving Clothes:

- Wool/Synthetic Material is preferred for:
 - Shirt
 - Pants/shorts
 - Pullover/sweater
 - Socks
- Cotton/Denim Material Preferred for:
 - Outer layer of clothing to protect wool/synthetic materials from getting dirty

Texas/New Mexico caves tend to be warmer than TAG caves and have average temperatures in the 70s. This means that you will get hot in these caves, so the wool/synthetic clothing is not mandatory just recommended.

Things to Bring:

- Headlamps, we recommend bringing at least 3 sources of light
- Soft knee pads, hard plastic knee pads will damage the cave
- Gloves
- Plastic Nalgene (PSA: it will get banged up a lot in cave)
 - Metal water bottles aren't allowed in cave
 - *Optional:* Extra water bottle in case you have to use the restroom in cave
- Baby wipes/ wet wipes (to clean face/body post-cave)
- Extra batteries for headlamps
- Snacks for in cave (preferably snacks that don't leave crumbs)
- Change of clothes for post-caving shenanigans & drive home
- Trash bag/Grocery bag for dirty caving clothes
- *Optional:* Pocket knife
